Legal Rights

- A. Each client will be treated as an adult, with respect to dignity regardless of race, color, sex or creed.
- B. Activities will promote positive attitudes with encouragement to participate.
- C. Our goal is to encourage learning, growth, and awareness in constructive ways to develop one's talents and interest.
- D. We also would encourage and maintain one's independence to the extent that conditions and circumstances permit, and to be involved with services designed to promote personal independence.
- E. We would like client to attain self-determination without our program, by taking part and getting involved with planning and participation.
- F. We will respect the client's wishes if they do not want to participate or get involved with daily activities.
- G. Our clients will be cared for in an atmosphere of sincere interest and concern, and staff will be available to assist with their needs.
- H. Our clients will have access to a phone and can receive phone calls, unless necessary restrictions are indicated in the individual's plan.
- I. All clients will have privacy and confidentiality. Unless needed to help with bathroom duties as specified in client's plan.
- J. All clients will be free of mental and physical abuse.
- K. We will not have restraints in our program, unless it is specified in the care plan and/or per doctor's orders. Clients may have time in their room to take a few moments to cool down or get away from others if warranted.
- L. Our clients will be free of interference, coercion (persuading them to do something by force or threat), discrimination or reprisal (retaliation).
